

Agreement to Come to and From School Unaccompanied

As children reach year 5 and 6, it is important that they begin to develop some of the independence skills they will require in order to be ready for secondary school. Frequently, year 5 and 6 are given the privilege of being able to travel to and from school unaccompanied. This is something that we promote at Haylands.

In order to make this a success, we ask you to sign the following agreement:

- We (my child and I) both believe that my child has a good awareness of road safety
- We both believe that my child knows to be at school between 8.30 & 8.40am
- We both believe that my child can uphold the school values and expectations when unaccompanied e.g.
 - Walk sensibly on the pavements
 - Be polite and respectful to others around us
 - Refrain from running and/or being an obstacle to other parents / members of the public
 - Behaving in a manner that would be acceptable in school to our fellow pupils e.g. no arguing, rough play or fighting
 - Using mobile phones appropriately
