

Uniform changes moving in to Key Stage 2

Uniform can be generic clothing from your chosen store (apart from the tie). Items branded with our Haylands logo can be purchased if you wish, however this is not essential. Clothing with our school logo is available from Kids & Co on Ryde high street.

There are some changes to the uniform once your child moves in to year 3:

- White shirt OR blouse
- Haylands school tie (purchased from Kids & Co)
- Red school V-neck sweatshirt or cardigan
- Black or grey skirt, pinafore, trousers or shorts
- Children should wear sensible black school shoes trainers.
- Grey, white or black plain socks



In the summer, grey or black school shorts or a red and white checked summer dress can be worn if chosen.

Other Information

- The PE kit remains the same as in KS1.
- All items must be labelled with the child's name.
- Children will need a generic backpack or school bag of their choice instead of a book bag.
- A named water bottle is required.
- Stud earrings only which must be removed on PE days.
- No nail varnish
- Long hair <u>MUST</u> be tied back (longer than shoulders).
