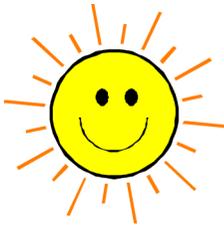

We are now using an online system called Class Dojo. This can be accessed on your computer through google or you can download an app to your smartphone. On this system, you get a weekly report about how your child is doing in school, you can access a class blog where photos and class information are uploaded and use a service to privately message the class teacher and for the teacher to contact you. Each child has a unique login so only their parent can see the messages sent to or from the teacher and can only access that class blog.
