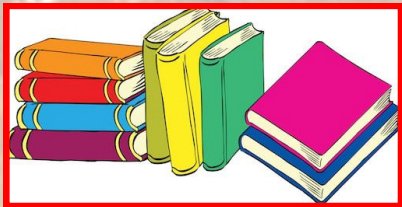

We would like to welcome our new Parent Governor Dionne Janeway , who has been elected unopposed. Thank you to Dionne for generously offering her time to the school.

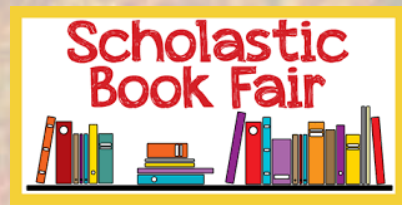
