### Dinner Money

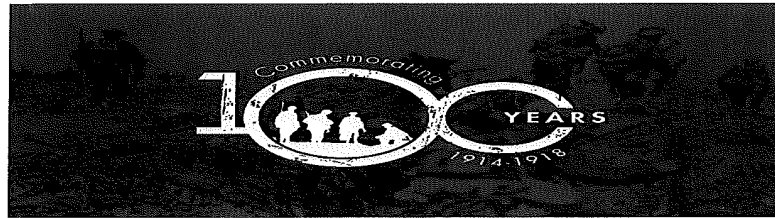
Reminder - School dinners now **cost £1.95** per day. Please send dinner money into school in a named envelope at the beginning of the week.
