Preventing winter bugs

Cold and flu viruses are doing the rounds at the moment, as well as others, and are easily passed on. These three simple steps, Catch It, Bin It, Kill It, can help prevent them from spreading.

Catch it - Germs spread easily. Always carry tissues and use them to catch your cough or sneeze

Bin it - Germs can live for several hours on tissues. Dispose of your tissue as soon as possible.

Kill it - Hands can transfer germs to every surface you touch. Wash your hands with soap and water.



Norovirus which causes diarrhoea and vomiting, is one of the most common stomach bugs in the UK.

It's also called the winter vomiting bug because it's more common in winter, although you can catch it at any time of the year. Norovirus can be very unpleasant but it usually clears up by itself in a few days. You can normally look after yourself or your child at home. Try to avoid going to your GP, as norovirus can spread to others very easily.
